2. Please ensure that the advertisement for your event, in the ESNZ Bulletin makes reference to the award and clarifies that it is only open to horses registered with the NZ Hanoverian Society. Proof of registration (copy of Pink Papers) must accompany entries.
2. Please pass on to your Event Convener the Rules and Action to be Taken form; the two sashes; the Results Form and the stamped addressed envelope to accompany this.

Should your organization not wish to participate in the programme please return everything enclosed to Julian Aaron. I have not enclosed an envelope for this return as the probability is that it won't be needed !!

The N Z Hanoverian Society is aware that the award does require extra effort from your Championship staff, for which we thank them, but feel that this award does add an additional dimension for quite a large number of competitors.

Rules and Action to be Taken for the N Z Hanoverian Society Awards 2013/2014

Prior to the Event

1. As this award is open ONLY to horses registered with the N Z Hanoverian Society, proof of registration MUST be obtained. Please ensure that, in any advertisements for your event it is clearly stated that, copies of PINK PAPERS stamped with the official "H" as proof of registration must be included with the entries.
2. Where possible we would like a representative of the N Z Hanoverian Society to present the sashes to the winners ; this is something which we leave entirely to you ; if you know that on the Showground you have a Hanoverian Society Committee member present we would ask you to arrange for that person to make the presentation . But please do not regard this as an essential rule !!

During the Event

1. There will be TWO awards presented this season
 - a) Level 1 – 3
 - b) Level 4 and above
2. Points will be allocated on the same basis as the Event Secretary uses to determine grade champions at the event. In the event of a tie i.e. two or more horses obtaining the same number of points, the winner will be the horse with the higher percentage. If there is still a tie, both names will be placed in a hat or other container with the draw being made as directed by the event secretary and winner will be the first name pulled out.
3. Presentation of the sashes will be in accordance with the prize giving procedures of the event but remembering our preference as above.

Post the Event

1. Please complete the attached Event Report Form, advising the winners of the sash, and the photographer present. This will enable the NZ Hanoverian Society to print the results and hopefully a photo to accompany this, in the regular colour print newsletter. An envelope addressed to the NZ Hanoverian Newsletter editor, Kim Morrison, is provided for you.
